Explanation of events

- **Field trip/tours** – we will bring a class of 9th-12th graders or/and a group from our Young Manufacturers Association - YMA to take a 15min-20min tour, 15min-20min info. Session about the company and 5min-10min Q&A session (all trips and tours should be less than 1hr in a group of 20 people or less but customizable)
- **Mentors** – The M3C program is looking to recruit mentors on an ongoing basis to mentor our 9th-12th graders
- **MFG Day** – We would like our partner companies to do a demonstration or man a table to explain an activity the company participated in ex... ABC company did a job shadow last year with the M3C program; ABC company will sit at the table and explain to the MC participants the benefits of getting involved with the MC program. This event is set up like a job fair and the participants will have a passport and they will receive a stamp for every table they visit and receive a prize if they get their passport filled
- **Partner Advisory Meeting** – Quarterly meeting between MC staff and Industry partners to make decisions regarding the M3C program for 1hr
- **College/Career/Career Day Guest speakers-** come to the school to speak about your college and career experience
- **P.R.I.D.E. guest speaker** – speak on one principal of pride our professionalism/soft skills training. P=professionalism, R=resilience, I=Intensity, D=Discernment, E=Evidence
- **Job shadow/Spring Break Internship/Summer job** – We want 100% of our participants to experience 2-4 work experiences (job shadow 1 day shadow unpaid, SBI 40hr work week at a partner company salary and WC is covered through CPS, summer job – 6weeks of FT employment at the partner company on the partner companies payroll **Career Jobs** – Interview our graduating seniors for career jobs with your company
- **MFG Impact** – summer internship for 9th & 10th graders; we will tour your facility and learn why you chose to produce the product that you make and how that part or your work impact the community
